## SMB

The smb ioslave enables you to browse the shares of a Windows<sup>®</sup> (or Samba) network.

To see the workgroups, enter **smb: /** .

**smb:// a\_workgroup** will list the hosts in this workgroup.

To see the shares of a host, enter **smb:// the\_host** or **smb:/ a\_workgroup / the\_host**.

To access a share directly enter **smb:// the\_host/the\_share** or **smb:/ a\_workgroup / the\_host / the\_share**

The smb ioslave requires that you have libsmbclient to use this ioslave.

You can set your default user name and password in the System Settings category **Network and Connectivity in Sharing** → **Windows Shares**. This is especially useful if you are a member of a Windows<sup>®</sup> NT domain. There you can also set your workgroup name, but in most cases this is not required. The kioslave will ask for your username and password if a default is not set.

This ioslave is tested and developed using mainly Samba 2.0.7, but other versions of Samba should work too.
